### Overview:

**No 'disagree' responses, majority is positive feedback**

**Many improvements in % 'strongly agree' from 2016 (q. 2,5,6,7,8,10)**

**Strength is q 8 = 93% 'strongly agreed' the school provided a solid foundation for their child's future, up from 80% in 2016.**

*n.b. 1 very negative questionnaire with list of issues relating to Pets as Therapy dog, overall behaviour, FONS, church services. Not all disagree responses but many. Anonymous so cannot respond, will invite discussion through feedback in newsletter.*

2 questions prompted additional '**tend to disagree**' responses to above questionnaire:

Q 5 = meets the social needs of my child (11% tend to disagree = 4 responses)

Action - To be investigated

Q 11 = communication of upcoming events is good (18% tend to disagree = 5 responses)

**note** includes communication about events.

**Highlighted in 2016 and no improvement seen, reduction in 'strongly agree' responses – continues to be a focus and area that has not been influenced by changes made (website, more newsletters, parent workshops, termly curriculum letters). May need to consider use of twitter and electronic communication.**

### **Actions:**

- **Yearly calendar to be produced in September.**
- **Weekly reminders to be parent mailed as well as parent workshop in autumn term about how to improve these 2 aspects.**
- **Termly 'drop-ins' for parents to be organised following summer session that was well received.**
