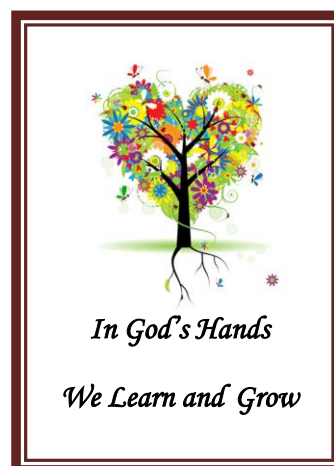
Swimming Pool
