You will be aware that we work very closely with our partner school, St. Michael's Infant School in Mickleham, and wanted to share the good news that following an Ofsted inspection, they were recently judged as a good **school**. There were many positive aspects that were noted in the report including a, 'strong, caring and nurturing ethos', 'a well organised and ambitious curriculum' and high expectations of pupils. Inspectors observed thoughtful and strong leadership at all levels that has a positive effect on pupil development and staff workload. They also acknowledged the work that has been done to plan and organise their curriculum so that it is accessible and meaningful for **ALL** children. One pupil summed up the school by saying, 'Everyone here has a kind heart.' We are really pleased for them and thrilled that many of the practices and the ethos that is mirrored across both schools were recognised in the inspection.
